In September 2010, the regulation of over 50,000 pharmacists, pharmacy technicians and pharmacy premises in England, Scotland and Wales will be transferred from the Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain (RPSGB) to the General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC).

To help you to understand changes to pharmacy regulation, which will occur in terms of standards, registration and renewal, and continuing professional development (CPD) the GPhC has launched a temporary helpline to assist individuals who have questions relating to the changes and how they will be affected by them.
